❖ **Parking** (barricades will be placed indicating spaces and hours of restricted parking)

◆ Will be restricted on the following dates and times in the following areas:

- **From 9:00am to 5:00pm on May 26-28th & May 30-June 1st**
 - **Both sides of SE Clinton St., between SE 14th & 16th Aves.**
 - **Both sides of SE 15th Ave., between SE Ivon & Clinton Sts.**

❖ **Traffic** (barricades will be placed indicating streets closed for production)

◆ Will be restricted on the following dates and times in the following areas:

- **From 10:00am to 2:00pm on May 26 & 28th**
- **From 9:00am to 4:00pm on May 27th**
- **From 9:00am to 1:00pm & 2:00pm to 8:00pm on May 30th**
- **From 12:00pm to 4:00pm on May 31st & June 1st**
 - **SE Clinton St. between SE 14th & SE 16th Aves.**
 - **SE 15th St. between SE Ivon & SE Taggart Sts.**
